



Seven reasons to use Kahoot!

- 1. Fast Fast to register for, create, play, and see results of kahoots

- **4. Flexible** Device agnostic, enables access via browser and app, and offers variety of game options and personalization
- 5. Collaborative Can share kahoots with other Kahoot! users
- Organized Can create kahoots in groups and favorite for easy retrieval and use

How to get started using Kahoot!

- 1. Create a Kahoot! account at getkahoot.com
- 2. Sign in at create.kahoot.it
- Create a new kahoot using Quiz, Jumble, Discussion, or Survey options
- 4. Once in the classroom, open kahoot you wish to deploy and click the Play button
- 5. Adjust settings as needed and select Classic or Team mode
- 6. Kahoot! displays the game's pin, enabling students to start playing
- Get playing! Note: If for attendance and participation, have students use real names
